FINISHED RECTANGLE SIZES: 4" x 8" and 4" x 12"

FINISHED SQUARE SIZE: 4" x 4"

FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 52½" x 70½"

- Yardages are based on 40" fabric width.

Materials

- ⅔ yd. Multicolor Panel (1JPE1) for quilt center
- ⅔ yd. Multicolor/Black Large Floral (2JPE1) for rectangles
- ⅔ yd. Multicolor/Yellow Large Floral (2JPE3) for rectangles and squares
- 1¼ yds. Multicolor Floral Stripe (8JPE1) for strips, rectangles, and squares
- ¼ yd. Pumpkin – Dark Orange – Solid (1MSA12) for squares
- ¼ yd. Spice – Light Orange – Solid (1MSA13) for squares
- ⅔ yd. Springtime – Light Green – Solid (1MSA17) for rectangles and squares
- 1½ yds. Moss – Dark Green – Solid (1MSA20) for rectangles and squares
- 1¼ yds. Aqua Solid (1MSA27) for strips and rectangles
- 3⅝ yds. for backing (horizontal seam)

Cutting

Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed.

From Multicolor Panel:

- Trim selvages from panel, and make sure that all four sides of panel are straight and square to each other (The size of the cut panel is less important than the straightness of the panel. If you prewash your panel it will appear narrower – when sewn into the quilt – than the one in the photo.)

From Multicolor/Black Large Floral, cut:

- 2 strips, 4½" x 40"; crosscut 4 rectangles, 4½" x 12½"

From Multicolor/Yellow Large Floral, cut:

- 2 strips, 4½" x 40"; first crosscut 4 rectangles, 4½" x 12½"; then crosscut 4 squares, 4½" x 4½"

From Multicolor Floral Stripe, selectively cut:

- 4 lengthwise strips, 4½" x 36½" (Selectively cut strips to get the portion of stripe design – plus seam allowance – as shown in photograph.)
- 4 lengthwise rectangles, 4½" x 8½"
- 4 squares, 4½" x 4½"

From Pumpkin – Dark Orange – Solid, cut:

- 1 strip, 4½" x 40"; crosscut 7 squares, 4½" x 4½"

From Spice – Light Orange – Solid, cut:

- 1 strip, 4½" x 40"; crosscut 7 squares, 4½" x 4½"

From Springtime – Light Green – Solid, cut:

- 2 strips, 4½" x 40"; first crosscut 4 rectangles, 4½" x 12½"; then crosscut 1 rectangle, 4½" x 8½"; then crosscut 2 squares, 4½" x 4½"

From Moss – Dark Green – Solid, cut:

- 2 strips, 4½" x 40"; first crosscut 4 rectangles, 4½" x 12½"; then crosscut 1 rectangle, 4½" x 8½"; then crosscut 2 squares, 4½" x 4½"
- 7 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding

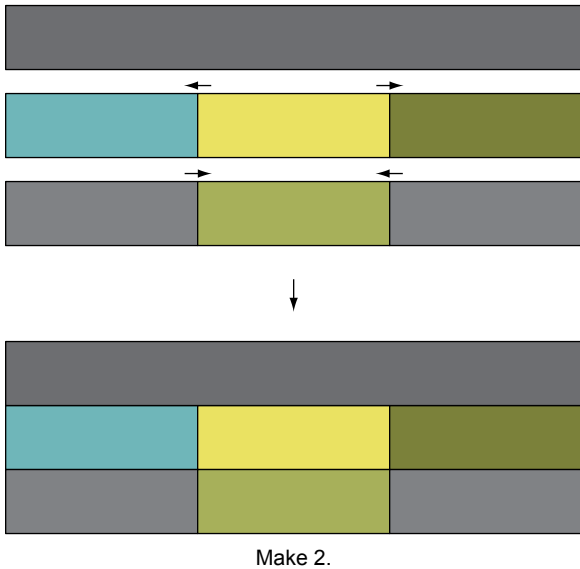
From Aqua Solid, cut:

- 4 strips, 4½" x 40"; first crosscut 4 rectangles, 4½" x 12½"; then sew remaining strips (2 complete strips + 1 partial strip) together end-to-end to make one long strip; from that long strip cut 2 strips, 4½" x 44½"
- 2 rectangles, 7½" x 25" (These are for the panel sides, and will be trimmed to size later.)

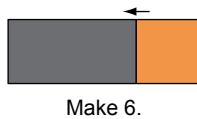
Quilt Top Assembly

All seams $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press seams in direction of arrows unless otherwise instructed. Refer to photograph for fabric placement.

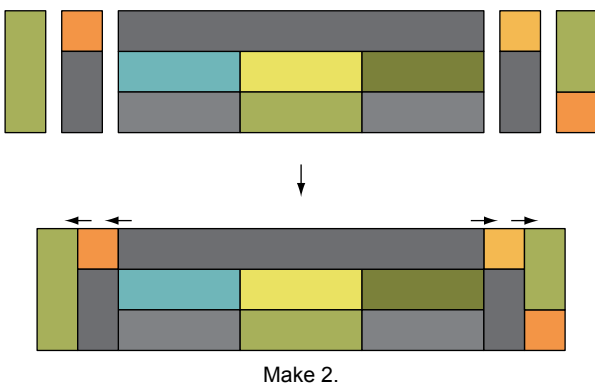
- Using 6 assorted $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, and 1 Multicolor Floral Stripe $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, assemble a rectangle section as shown. Repeat to make a total of 2 sections.



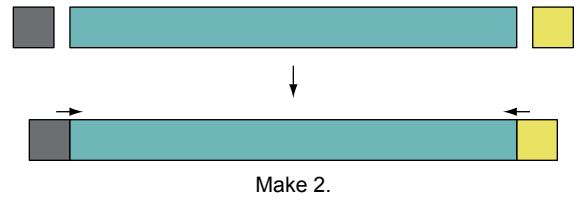
- Using 1 assorted $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, and 1 assorted $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square, assemble a rectangle unit as shown. Repeat to make a total of 6 units.



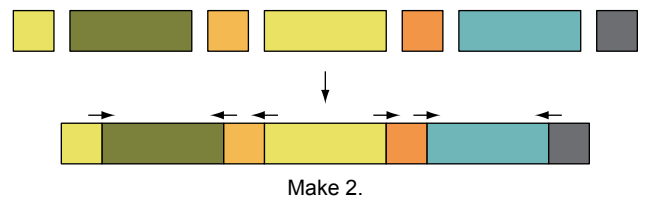
- Using 1 rectangle section from Step 1, 3 rectangle units from Step 2, and 1 assorted $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, assemble a pieced section as shown. Repeat to make a total of 2 sections.



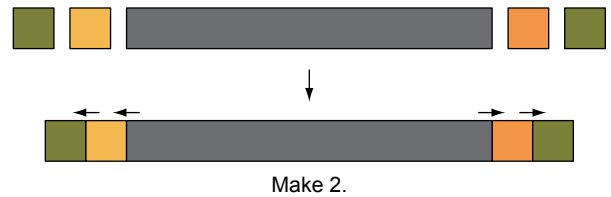
- Using 1 Aqua Solid $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $44\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, and 2 assorted $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, assemble a row as shown. Repeat to make a total of 2 rows.



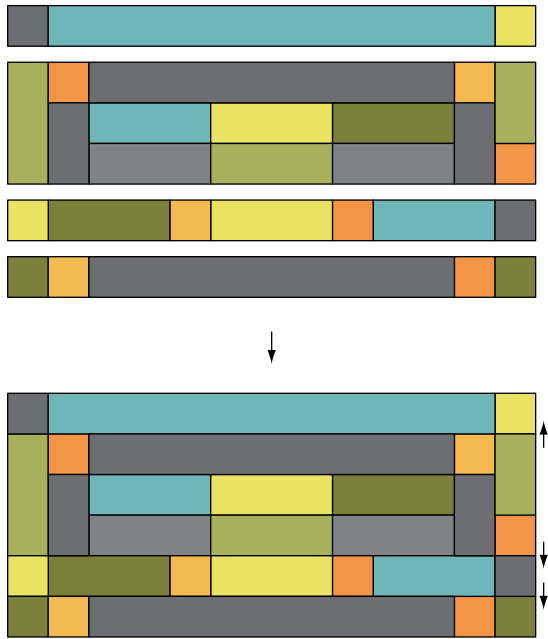
- Using 3 assorted $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, and 4 assorted $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, assemble a row as shown. Repeat to make a total of 2 rows.



- Using 1 Multicolor Floral Stripe $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, and 4 assorted $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, assemble a row as shown. Repeat to make a total of 2 rows.



7. Using 1 section from Step 3, and 1 row each from Steps 4, 5, and 6, assemble a section as shown. Repeat to make a total of 2 sections.



Make 2.

8. Measure the top-to-bottom length of the Multicolor panel (it should be approximately in the range of 21½" -22½"), and trim the 2 Aqua Solid 7½" x 25" rectangles to this measurement. Sew the trimmed rectangles to the sides of the panel.



Make 1.

9. Measure the width (longest direction) of each section made in Step 7. If they do not measure the same, take an average of the 2 measurements. Trim the panel section made in Step 8 to this measurement, making sure to trim equally from each side.
10. Sew together the trimmed panel section, and the 2 sections made in Step 7, as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press seams toward the panel section.

Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
