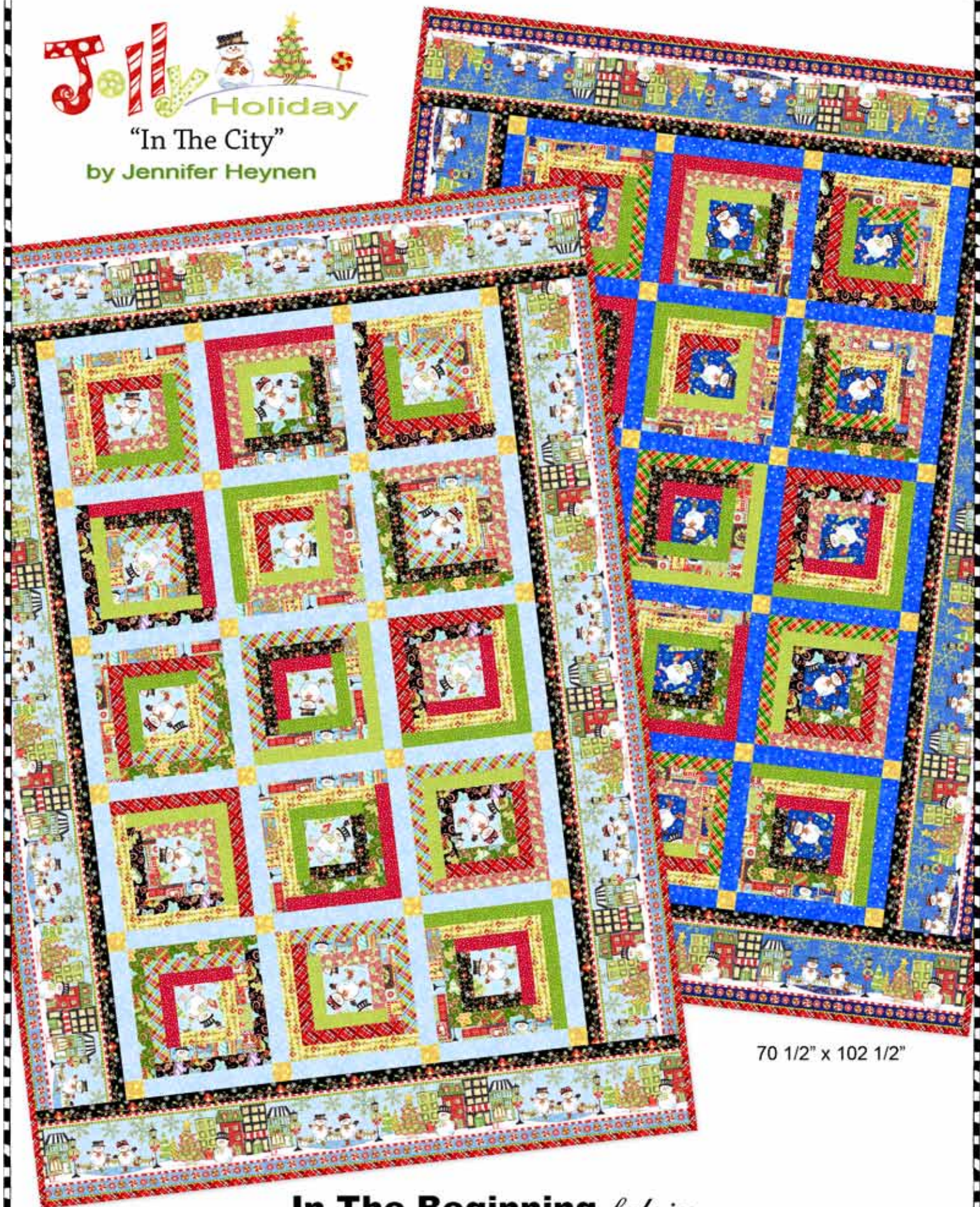

FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 69½" x 101½"

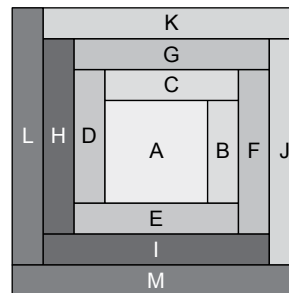
- A separate materials list is given for each of the two quilts.
- Yardages are based on 40" fabric width.

Materials: Sky Blue Quilt

- 1¼ yds. Sky Snowmen/Trees (3JHI1) for blocks
- ¾ yd. Black Ornaments (4JHI2) for blocks
- ¾ yd. Green Ornaments (4JHI3) for blocks
- ¾ yd. Sky Collage (2JHI1) for blocks
- ½ yd. Yellow Birds (5JHI2) for blocks
- ⅓ yd. Black Birds (5JHI3) for blocks
- ½ yd. Red/Green Swirls (7JHI1) for blocks
- ½ yd. Lime Dots (9JHI2) for blocks
- ½ yd. Forest Dots (9JHI3) for blocks
- ¾ yd. Red Dots (9JHI4) for blocks
- ½ yd. Red/Sky Plaid (6JHI1) for blocks
- 1¼ yds. Red Plaid (6JHI3) for blocks and binding
- 1⅝ yds. Sky Snowflakes (8JHI1) for sashing rectangles
- ¼ yd. Yellow Swirls (7JHI2) for sashing squares
- 3¼ yds. Sky Border Stripe (1JHI1) for border
- 6½ yds. for backing (vertical seam)

Materials: Royal Blue Quilt

- 1¼ yds. Royal Snowmen/Trees (3JHI2) for blocks
- ¾ yd. Black Ornaments (4JHI2) for blocks
- ¾ yd. Green Ornaments (4JHI3) for blocks
- ⅔ yd. Royal Collage (2JHI2) for blocks
- ½ yd. Yellow Birds (5JHI2) for blocks
- ⅓ yd. Black Birds (5JHI3) for blocks
- ½ yd. Red/Green Swirls (7JHI1) for blocks
- ½ yd. Lime Dots (9JHI2) for blocks
- ½ yd. Forest Dots (9JHI3) for blocks
- ¾ yd. Red Dots (9JHI4) for blocks
- ½ yd. Red/Green Plaid (6JHI2) for blocks
- 1¼ yds. Red Plaid (6JHI3) for blocks and binding
- 1⅝ yds. Royal Snowflakes (8JHI2) for sashing rectangles
- ¼ yd. Yellow Swirls (7JHI2) for sashing squares
- 3¼ yds. Royal Border Stripe (1JHI2) for border
- 6½ yds. for backing (vertical seam)



Cutting

One set of cutting instructions is given, and can be used for either of the two quilts. Fabrics are cut in order given in Materials lists. Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed.

Tip: After cutting fabric for A-M shapes, put your cut pieces in labeled envelopes or baggies. (Labeling information could include quilt name, size/shape of piece, and identifying letter.) When you are ready to sew, your pieces will be easy to find and use.

From Snowmen/Trees, selectively cut:

- 15 squares, 5½" x 5½", for A squares

From Black Ornaments, cut:

- 4 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 2 M rectangles, 2" x 14½"; 2 L rectangles, 2" x 13"; 1 K rectangle, 2" x 13"; 1 J rectangle, 2" x 11½"; 2 G rectangles, 2" x 10"; 2 F rectangles, 2" x 8½"; 1 E rectangle, 2" x 8½"; 1 D rectangle, 2" x 7"

From Green Ornaments, cut:

- 4 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 2 M rectangles, 2" x 14½"; 2 L rectangles, 2" x 13"; 1 K rectangle, 2" x 13"; 1 J rectangle, 2" x 11½"; 2 G rectangles, 2" x 10"; 2 F rectangles, 2" x 8½"; 2 C rectangles, 2" x 7"; 2 B rectangles, 2" x 5½"

From Collage, cut:

- 8 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 4 M rectangles, 2" x 14½"; 4 L rectangles, 2" x 13"; 2 K rectangles, 2" x 13"; 2 J rectangles, 2" x 11½"; 1 I rectangle, 2" x 11½"; 1 H rectangle, 2" x 10"; 4 G rectangles, 2" x 10"; 4 F rectangles, 2" x 8½"; 1 E rectangle, 2" x 8½"; 1 D rectangle, 2" x 7"; 1 C rectangle, 2" x 7"; 1 B rectangle, 2" x 5½"

From Yellow Birds, cut:

- 6 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 1 M rectangle, 2" x 14½"; 1 L rectangle, 2" x 13"; 2 K rectangles, 2" x 13"; 2 J rectangles, 2" x 11½"; 4 I rectangles, 2" x 11½"; 4 H rectangles, 2" x 10"; 1 G rectangle, 2" x 10"; 1 F rectangle, 2" x 8½"; 3 C rectangles, 2" x 7"; 3 B rectangles, 2" x 5½"

From Black Birds, cut:

- 3 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 1 I rectangle, 2" x 11½"; 1 H rectangle, 2" x 10"; 3 G rectangles, 2" x 10"; 3 F rectangles, 2" x 8½"; 2 C rectangles, 2" x 7"; 2 B rectangles, 2" x 5½"

From Red/Green Swirls, cut:

- 5 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 2 K rectangles, 2" x 13"; 2 J rectangles, 2" x 11½"; 2 I rectangles, 2" x 11½"; 2 H rectangles, 2" x 10"; 1 E rectangle, 2" x 8½"; 1 D rectangle, 2" x 7"; 3 C rectangles, 2" x 7"; 3 B rectangles, 2" x 5½"

From Lime Dots, cut:

- 5 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 1 M rectangle, 2" x 14½"; 1 L rectangle, 2" x 13"; 3 I rectangles, 2" x 11½"; 3 H rectangles, 2" x 10"; 3 E rectangles, 2" x 8½"; 3 D rectangles, 2" x 7"

From Forest Dots, cut:

- 5 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 2 M rectangles, 2" x 14½"; 2 L rectangles, 2" x 13"; 1 K rectangle, 2" x 13"; 1 J rectangle, 2" x 11½"; 1 G rectangle, 2" x 10"; 1 F rectangle, 2" x 8½"; 4 E rectangles, 2" x 8½"; 4 D rectangles, 2" x 7"

From Red Dots, cut:

- 4 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 1 M rectangle, 2" x 14½"; 1 L rectangle, 2" x 13"; 2 K rectangles, 2" x 13"; 2 J rectangles, 2" x 11½"; 3 E rectangles, 2" x 8½"; 3 D rectangles, 2" x 7"; 1 C rectangle, 2" x 7"; 1 B rectangle, 2" x 5½"

From Red/Sky Plaid (Sky Blue Quilt) –OR– Red/Green Plaid (Royal Blue Quilt), cut:

- 5 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 1 M rectangle, 2" x 14½"; 1 L rectangle, 2" x 13"; 3 K rectangles, 2" x 13"; 3 J rectangles, 2" x 11½"; 1 I rectangle, 2" x 11½"; 1 H rectangle, 2" x 10"; 1 G rectangle, 2" x 10"; 1 F rectangle, 2" x 8½"; 1 E rectangle, 2" x 8½"; 1 D rectangle, 2" x 7"; 2 C rectangles, 2" x 7"; 2 B rectangles, 2" x 5½"

From Red Plaid, cut:

- 9 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding

(From Red Plaid, continued)

- 5 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 1 M rectangle, 2" x 14½"; 1 L rectangle, 2" x 13"; 1 K rectangle, 2" x 13"; 1 J rectangle, 2" x 11½"; 3 I rectangles, 2" x 11½"; 3 H rectangles, 2" x 10"; 1 G rectangle, 2" x 10"; 1 F rectangle, 2" x 8½"; 1 E rectangle, 2" x 8½"; 1 D rectangle, 2" x 7"; 1 C rectangle, 2" x 7"; 1 B rectangle, 2" x 5½"

From Snowflakes, cut:

- 19 strips, 2½" x 40"; crosscut 38 rectangles, 2½" x 14½", for sashing rectangles

From Yellow Swirls, cut:

- 2 strips, 2½" x 40"; crosscut 24 squares, 2½" x 2½", for sashing squares

From Border Stripe, selectively cut:

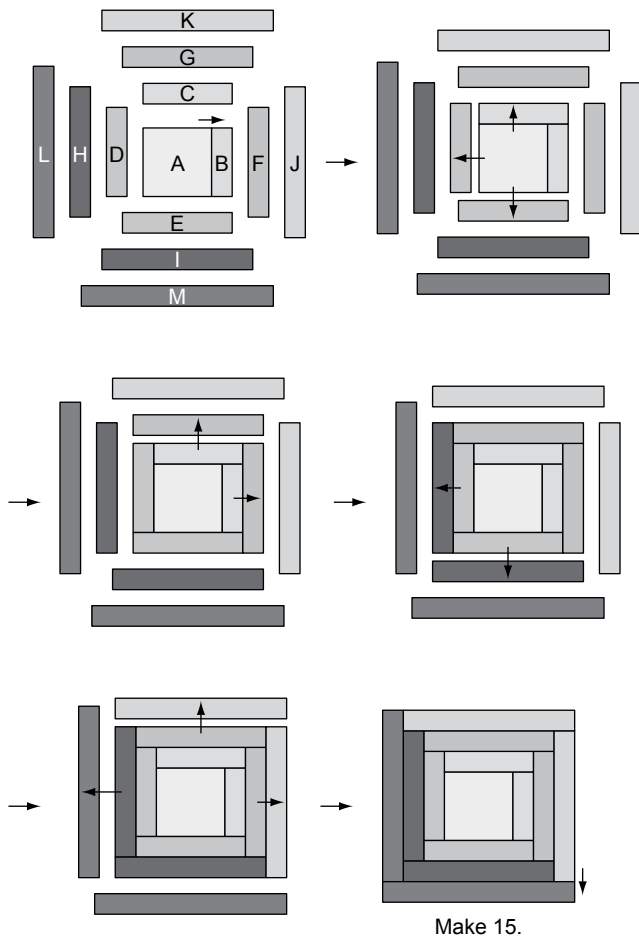
- 4 strips, 10" x length of fabric, for border (Selectively cut strips to get the portion of stripe design – plus seam allowance – as shown in photographs; strips are cut long and will be trimmed to size later.)

Quilt Top Assembly

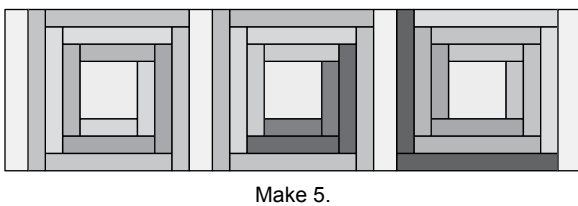
All seams ¼". Press seams in direction of arrows unless otherwise instructed. Assembly instructions are the same for both quilts.

1. Referring to the cover photograph for fabric placement, and using these pieces:
 - (1) 5½" A square
 - (1) 2" x 5½" B rectangle
 - (1) 2" x 7" C rectangle
 - (1) 2" x 7" D rectangle
 - (1) 2" x 8½" E rectangle
 - (1) 2" x 8½" F rectangle
 - (1) 2" x 10" G rectangle
 - (1) 2" x 10" H rectangle
 - (1) 2" x 11½" I rectangle
 - (1) 2" x 11½" J rectangle
 - (1) 2" x 13" K rectangle
 - (1) 2" x 13" L rectangle
 - (1) 2" x 14½" M rectangle...assemble a Log Cabin block. (See Block Assembly Diagram on back page.) Repeat to make a total of 15 blocks.

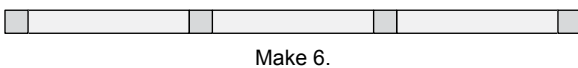
Block Assembly Diagram



2. Sew 3 Log Cabin blocks and 4 Snowflakes $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing rectangles together in a row as shown. Press seams toward sashing rectangles. Repeat to make a total of 5 rows.



3. Sew 3 Snowflakes $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing rectangles, and 4 Yellow Swirls $2\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing squares together in a row as shown. Press seams toward sashing rectangles. Repeat to make a total of 6 rows.



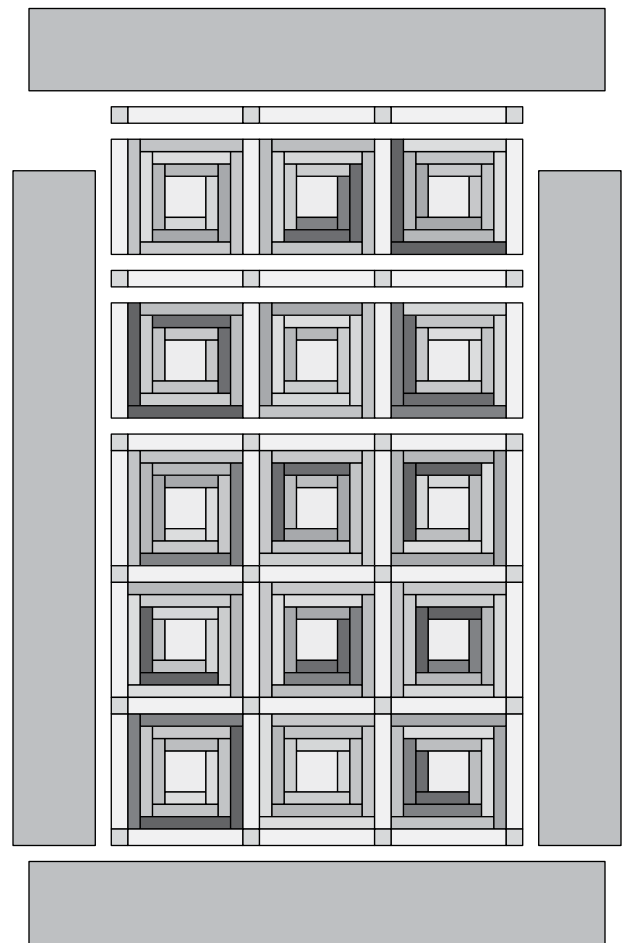
4. Sew rows from Steps 2 and 3 together as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press seams away from block rows.

Borders

1. Measure length of quilt top through center. Trim 2 Border Stripe strips to this measurement, and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward borders.
2. Measure width of quilt top, including borders just added, through center. Trim remaining 2 Border Stripe border strips to this measurement, and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward borders.

Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
