FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 8" x 8"

FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 40½" x 40½"

- *Quilt instructions are given for quilts in three different colorways.*
- *A separate materials list is given for each of the three quilts.*
- *Yardages are based on 40" fabric width.*

Materials: Turquoise Quilt

- ⅔ yd. Cream Animals (1JHK1) for blocks
- ½ yd. Cream Letters (2JHK1) for blocks
- ½ yd. Orange Plaid (3JHK1) for blocks
- ⅜ yd. Orange Dots (4JHK1) for blocks
- ¾ yd. Teal Dots (4JHK4) for blocks and binding
- ⅜ yd. Turquoise Tonal Flannel for blocks
- 1½ yds.* for backing

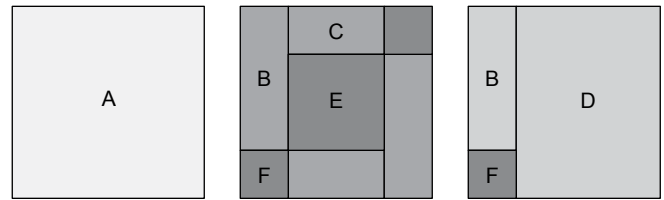
Materials: Blue Quilt

- ⅔ yd. Blue Animals (1JHK2) for blocks
- ½ yd. White Letters (2JHK2) for blocks
- ½ yd. Blue/Green Plaid (3JHK5) for blocks
- ⅜ yd. Green Dots (4JHK5) for blocks
- ⅜ yd. Blue Dots (4JHK2) for blocks
- ⅜ yd. Blue Plaid (3JHK2) for blocks
- ½ yd. Blue Tonal Flannel for binding
- 1½ yds.* for backing

Materials: Pink Quilt

- ⅔ yd. Pink Animals (1JHK3) for blocks
- ½ yd. Gray Letters (2JHK3) for blocks
- ½ yd. Gray Plaid (3JHK4) for blocks
- ⅜ yd. Gray Dots (4JHK6) for blocks
- ⅜ yd. Pink Dots (4JHK3) for blocks
- ⅜ yd. Pink Plaid (3JHK3) for blocks
- ½ yd. Pink Tonal Flannel for binding
- 1½ yds.* for backing

*1½ yds. will be enough if your fabric is at least 44" wide after pre-washing. If not, consider piecing in some of the leftovers from the front to get the needed width.



Cutting

One set of cutting instructions is given, and can be used for any of the quilts. Fabrics are cut in order given in Materials lists. Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed.

From Animals, cut:

- 2 strips, 8½" x 40"; crosscut 8 A squares, 8½" x 8½"

From Letters, cut:

- 1 strip, 6½" x 40"; crosscut 4 D rectangles, 6½" x 8½"
- 2 strips, 2½" x 40"; crosscut 1 strip into 6 B rectangles, 2½" x 6½". Crosscut the other strip into 2 more B rectangles, 2½" x 6½", and 4 C rectangles, 2½" x 4½"

From Orange Plaid (Turquoise Quilt) –OR– Blue/Green Plaid (Blue Quilt) –OR– Gray Plaid (Pink Quilt), cut:

- 1 strip, 8½" x 40"; crosscut 2 A squares, 8½" x 8½" (use remainder of strip for next step)
- 6 B rectangles, 2½" x 6½"
- 1 strip, 2½" x 40"; crosscut 6 C rectangles, 2½" x 4½"

From Orange Dots (Turquoise Quilt) –OR– Green Dots (Blue Quilt) –OR– Gray Dots (Pink Quilt), cut:

- 1 strip, 8½" x 40"; crosscut 2 A squares, 8½" x 8½"

From Teal Dots (Turquoise Quilt only), cut:

- 1 strip, 4½" x 40"; crosscut 5 E squares, 4½" x 4½"
- 1 strip, 2½" x 40"; crosscut 14 F squares, 2½" x 2½"
- 5 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding

From Blue Dots (Blue Quilt) –OR– Pink Dots (Pink Quilt), cut:

- 1 strip, 4½" x 40"; crosscut 5 E squares, 4½" x 4½"
- 1 strip, 2½" x 40"; crosscut 14 F squares, 2½" x 2½"

From Turquoise Tonal (Turquoise Quilt) –OR– Blue Plaid (Blue Quilt) –OR– Pink Plaid (Pink Quilt), cut:

- 1 strip, 8½" x 40"; crosscut 4 A squares, 8½" x 8½"

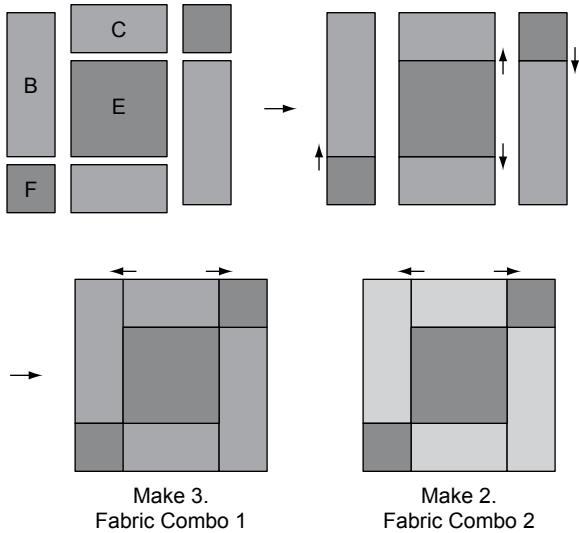
From Blue Tonal (Blue Quilt) –OR– Pink Tonal (Pink Quilt), cut:

- 5 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding

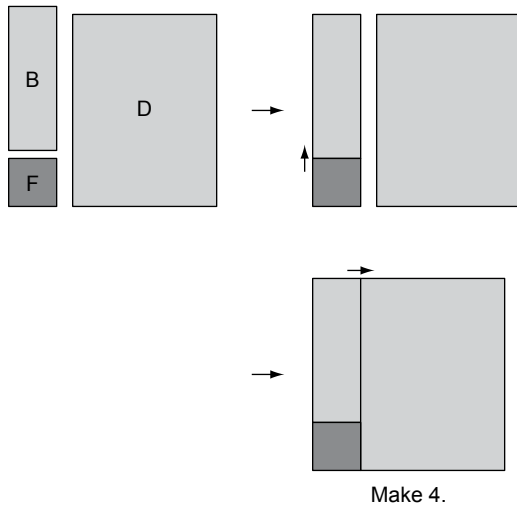
Block Assembly

All seams $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press seams in direction of arrows unless otherwise instructed.

- Referring to photos for fabric placement, and using (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " E square, (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " C rectangles, (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " B rectangles, and (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " F squares, assemble a block as shown. Repeat to make a total of 5 blocks (3 blocks in one fabric combination, and 2 blocks in a second fabric combination).



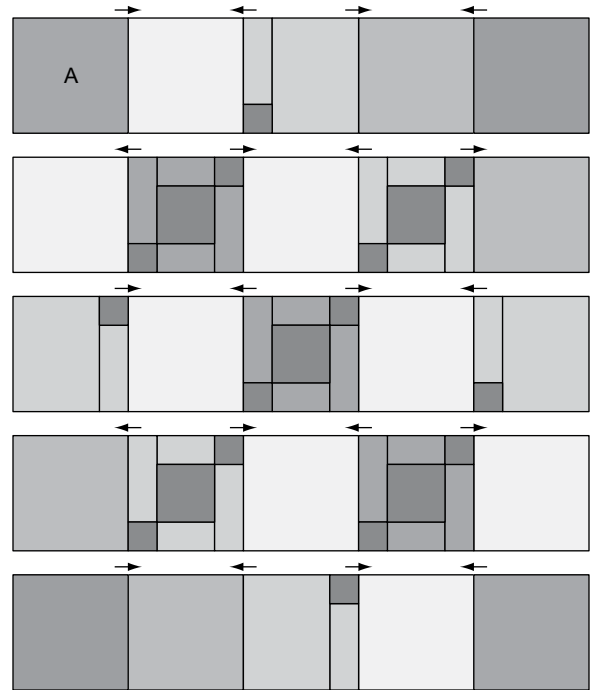
- Using (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " D rectangle, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " B rectangle, and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " F square, assemble a block as shown. Repeat to make a total of 4 blocks.



Quilt Top Assembly

Note: It might be helpful to arrange all $8\frac{1}{2}$ " A squares and all blocks on a design wall before sewing.

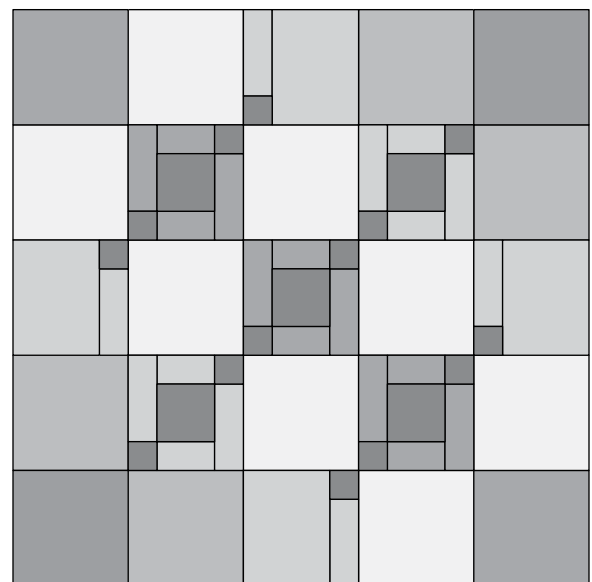
- Using all $8\frac{1}{2}$ " A squares and all blocks, assemble rows as shown.



- Sew rows together as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram below. Press seams away from center of quilt.

Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
