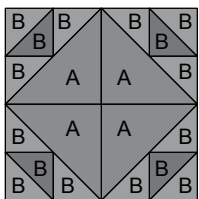
FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 68½" x 68½"
FINISHED LARGE BLOCK SIZE: 12" x 12"
FINISHED STAR BLOCK SIZE: 10" x 10"

Materials

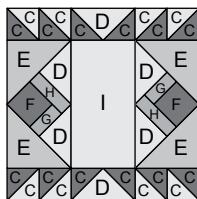
Yardage requirements are based on 40" fabric width.

1½ yds.* Black/Orange Large Floral (3FL1) for blocks
 ⅞ yd. Black/Orange Medium Floral (4FL1) for blocks
 1¼ yds. Green Tonal Leaves (8FL3) for blocks and inner border
 1⅔ yds. Gray Tonal Dots (9FL2) for blocks
 ⅔ yd. Yellow Sunflowers (7FL1) for blocks
 ¼ yd. Orange Leaves and Flowers (6FL1) for blocks
 2 yds.* Black Cat Border Stripe (2FL1) for outer border
 ¾ yd. Black Tonal Leaves (8FL5) for binding
 4½ yds. for backing

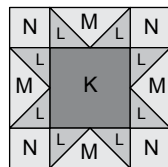
*Yardage is generous to allow for selective cutting.



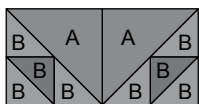

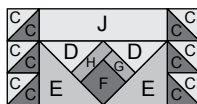

Cutting

Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed.

From Black/Orange Large Floral, cut:

- 28 triangles, using Template A (on back page)
- 4 squares, 5½" x 5½", for K squares

From Black/Orange Medium Floral, cut:

- 14 squares, 3⅞" x 3⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 28 of triangle B
- 48 squares, 2⅞" x 2⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 96 of triangle C
- 16 squares, 2½" x 2½", for F squares

From Green Tonal Leaves, cut in order given:

- 6 strips, 2½" x 40", for inner border (Inner border will be sewn to outer border, then trimmed to size.)
- 42 squares, 3⅞" x 3⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 84 of triangle B

From Gray Tonal Dots, cut:

- 4 squares, 6½" x 6½", for corner squares

- 4 squares, 6¼" x 6¼"; cut each square twice diagonally to make 16 of triangle M
- 10 squares, 5¼" x 5¼"; cut each square twice diagonally to make 40 of triangle D
- 4 rectangles, 4½" x 8½", for I rectangles
- 16 squares, 3" x 3", for N squares
- 40 squares, 2⅞" x 2⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 80 of triangle C
- 8 rectangles, 2½" x 8½", for J rectangles

From Yellow Sunflowers, cut:

- 16 squares, 4⅞" x 4⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 32 of triangle E
- 16 squares, 3⅞" x 3⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 32 of triangle L

From Orange Leaves and Flowers, cut:

- 16 rectangles, 1⅜" x 3⅜", for H rectangles
- 16 rectangles, 1⅜" x 2½", for G rectangles

From Black Cat Border Stripe, selectively cut:

- 4 lengthwise strips, 10" x 50", for outer border (If you prewash your fabric, you will need to cut your strips narrower than 10" to get the desired portion of the design. Plan your cuts so that you have at least ¼" of solid black on each side of the cat stripe. Strips are cut long, and will be trimmed to size later.)

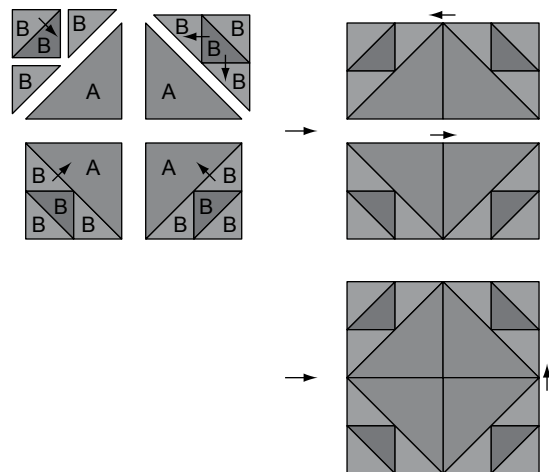
From Black Tonal Leaves, cut:

- 8 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding

Quilt Top Assembly

All seams ¼". Press seams in direction of arrows.

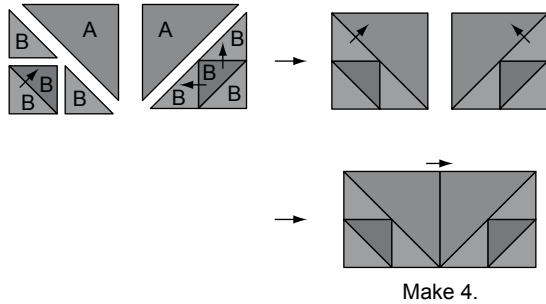
- Using 4 matching Black/Orange Large Floral A triangles, 12 Green Tonal Leaves B triangles, and 4 Black/Orange Medium Floral B triangles, assemble 1 A/B block as shown. Repeat to make a total of 5 blocks.



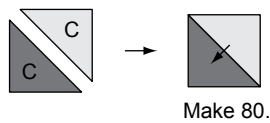
Make 5.

- Using 2 matching Black/Orange Large Floral A triangles, 6 Green Tonal Leaves B triangles, and 2 Black/

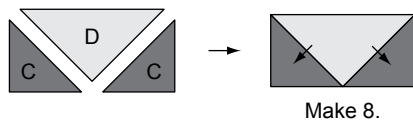
Orange Medium Floral B triangles, assemble 1 A/B side unit as shown. Repeat to make a total of 4 units.



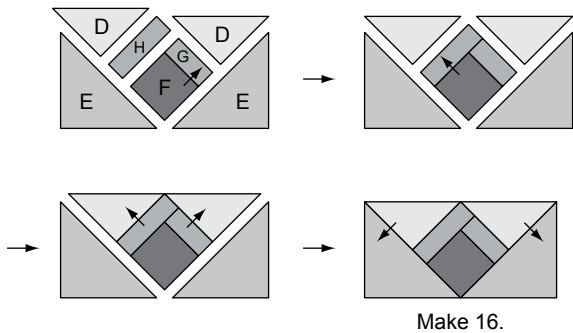
3. Using 1 Black/Orange Medium Floral C triangle, and 1 Gray Tonal Dots C triangle, make a C/C triangle unit as shown. Repeat to make a total of 80 units.



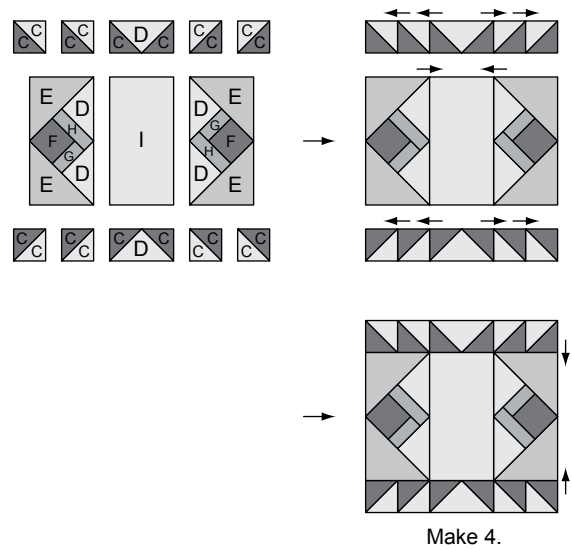
4. Using 1 Gray Tonal Dots D triangle, and 2 Black/Orange Medium Floral C triangles, make a C/D unit as shown. Repeat to make a total of 8 units.



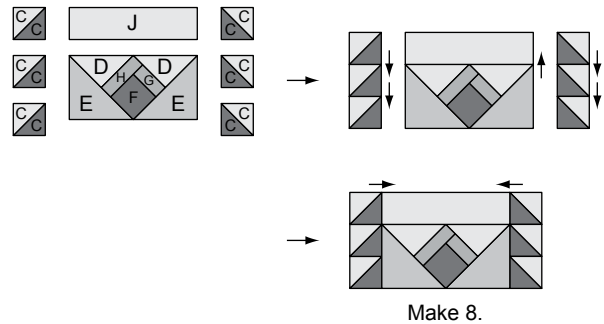
5. Using 1 Black/Orange Medium Floral F square, 1 Orange Leaves and Flowers G rectangle, 1 Orange Leaves and Flowers H rectangle, 2 Gray Tonal Dots D triangles, and 2 Yellow Sunflowers E triangles, assemble a D/E/F/G/H unit as shown. Repeat to make a total of 16 units.



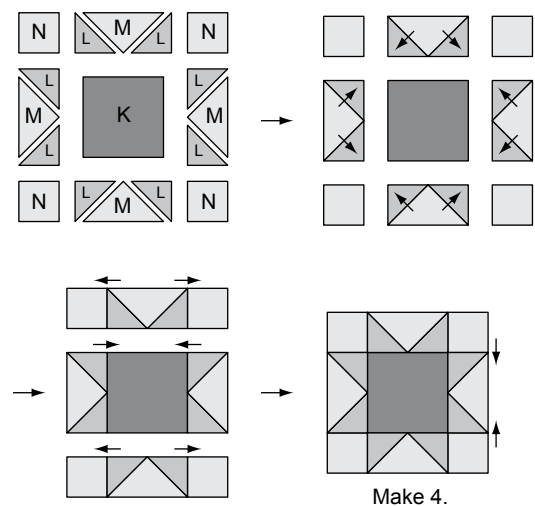
6. Using 1 Gray Tonal Dots I rectangle, 2 D/E/F/G/H units, 2 C/D units, and 8 C/C units, assemble a block as shown at top right. Repeat to make a total of 4 blocks.



7. Using 1 Gray Tonal Dots J rectangle, 1 D/E/F/G/H unit, and 6 C/C units, assemble a side unit as shown. Repeat to make a total of 8 units.



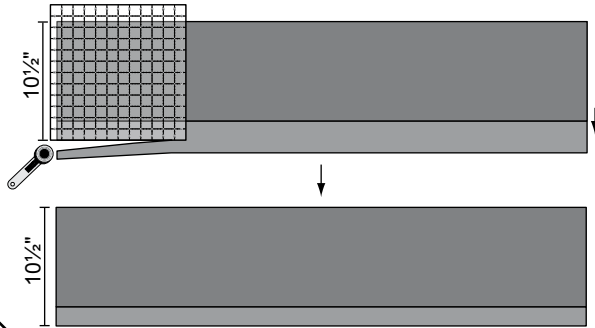
8. Using 1 Black/Orange Large Floral K square, 8 Yellow Sunflowers L triangles, 4 Gray Tonal Dots M triangles, and 4 Gray Tonal Dots N squares, assemble a star block as shown. Repeat to make a total of 4 blocks.



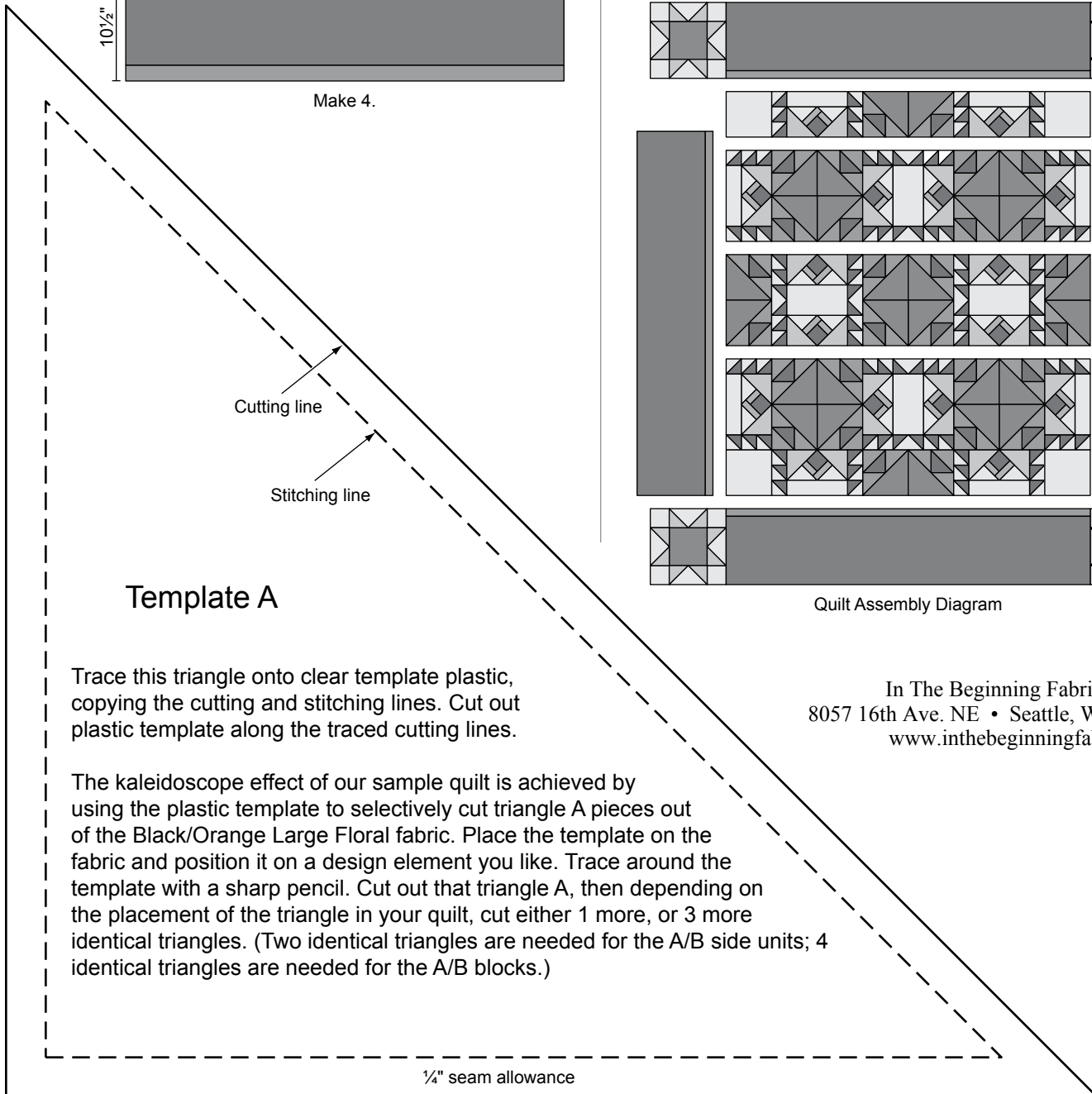
9. Sew Gray Tonal Dots 6½" squares, and all of the blocks and units made in Steps 1, 2, 6, and 7 together in rows as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram on the back page. Press for opposing seams. Sew rows together. Press seams in one direction.

Borders

1. Sew Green Tonal Leaves $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40" inner border strips together, end-to-end, to make one long strip. Press seams open. From long strip, cut 4 strips, each 50" long.
2. Sew a Green Tonal Leaves $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50" inner border strip to a Black Cat Border Stripe 10" x 50" outer border strip. After sewing inner and outer borders together, trim long edge of Green Tonal Leaves strip so that the total measurement of the pieced border is $10\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide. Repeat to make a total of 4 pieced borders.



Make 4.



Template A

Trace this triangle onto clear template plastic, copying the cutting and stitching lines. Cut out plastic template along the traced cutting lines.

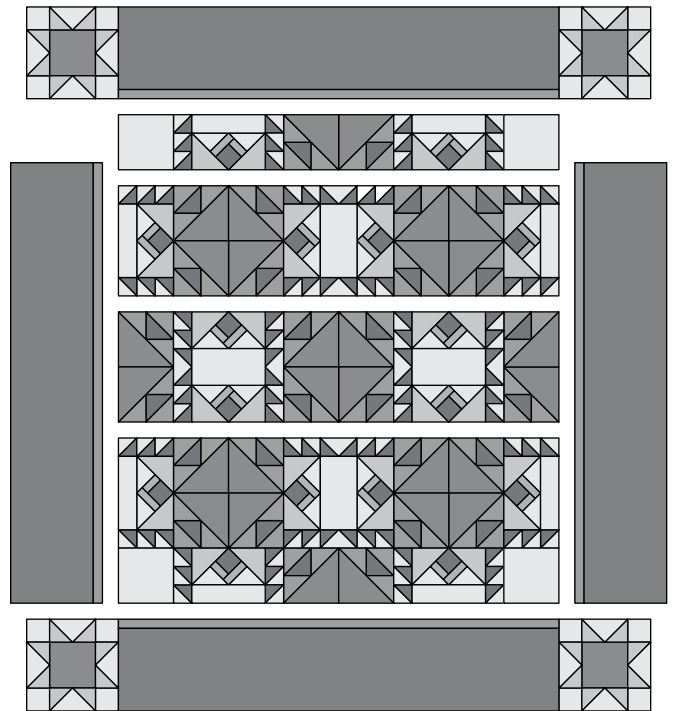
The kaleidoscope effect of our sample quilt is achieved by using the plastic template to selectively cut triangle A pieces out of the Black/Orange Large Floral fabric. Place the template on the fabric and position it on a design element you like. Trace around the template with a sharp pencil. Cut out that triangle A, then depending on the placement of the triangle in your quilt, cut either 1 more, or 3 more identical triangles. (Two identical triangles are needed for the A/B side units; 4 identical triangles are needed for the A/B blocks.)

$\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance

3. Measure width and length of quilt top through center. (Since the quilt is square, the measurement should be the same. If isn't, use the average of the two measurements.) Cut the 4 pieced borders to this size.
4. Sew a pieced border to each side of the quilt top as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram below. Press seams toward borders.
5. Sew a Star block to each side of each remaining pieced border. Press seams toward borders.
6. Sew Star block borders to top and bottom of quilt top. Press seams toward borders.

Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
