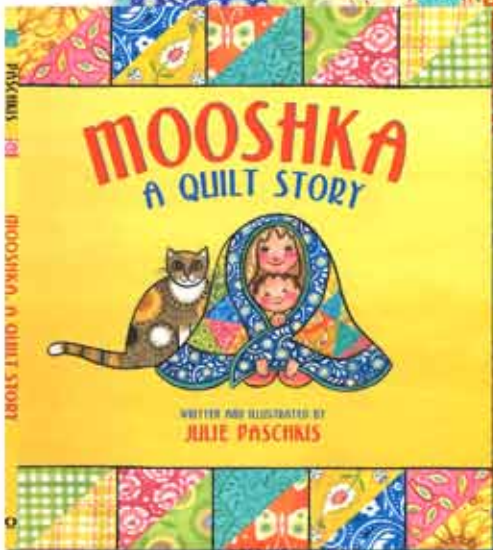




# MOOSHKA QUILT

INSPIRED BY MOOSHKA, A QUILT STORY  
BY JULIE PASCHKIS



**In The Beginning** *fabrics*

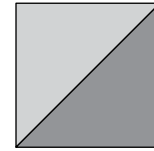
**FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 6" x 6"**

**FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 66½" x 96½"**

- Yardages are based on 40" fabric width.

### Materials

- 2⅝ yds. Blue/Yellow Sun Flowers (1JPD1) for border  
1½ yds. Blue Spotted Dots (11JPD1) for blocks and binding  
¾ yd. Red Roses (2JPD1) for blocks  
¾ yd. Yellow French Leaves (3JPD1) for blocks  
¾ yd. Blue Birds (4JPD1) for blocks  
¾ yd. Orange Butterflies (5JPD1) for blocks  
¾ yd. Turquoise Leaf Vines (6JPD1) for blocks  
¾ yd. Gold/Brown Crown Flower (7JPD1) for blocks  
¾ yd. Yellow Trifloral (8JPD1) for blocks  
¾ yd. Green Flowers and Buds (9JPD1) for blocks  
¾ yd. Green "C" Flowers (10JPD2) for blocks  
¾ yd. Yellow Plaid (12JPD1) for blocks  
¾ yd. Blue Bandana (13JPD1) for blocks  
6¼ yds. for backing (vertical seam)



### Cutting

*Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed.*

#### **Border and Binding Strips**

*From Blue/Yellow Sun Flowers, cut:*

- 4 strips, 6½" x length of fabric, for border (**Note:** Strips are cut long, and will be trimmed to size later.)

*From Blue Spotted Dots, cut:*

- 9 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding (**Note:** You will use remainder of Blue Spotted Dots print in the "Block Pieces" cutting step below.)

#### **Block Pieces**

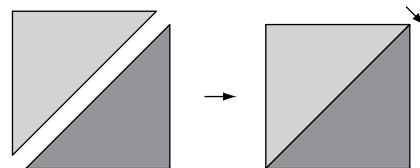
*From each ¾ yd. piece of fabric (11 total), plus remainder of Blue Spotted Dots print, cut:*

- 3 strips, 6⅞" x 40"; crosscut 11 squares, 6⅞" x 6⅞", cut each square once diagonally to make 22 triangles (**Note:** You will have one extra triangle from each print.)

### Assembly

*All seams ¼". Press seams in direction of arrows unless otherwise instructed. Refer to photograph for fabric placement.*

1. Using 2 assorted-print triangles, assemble a block as shown. Repeat to make a total of 126 blocks.



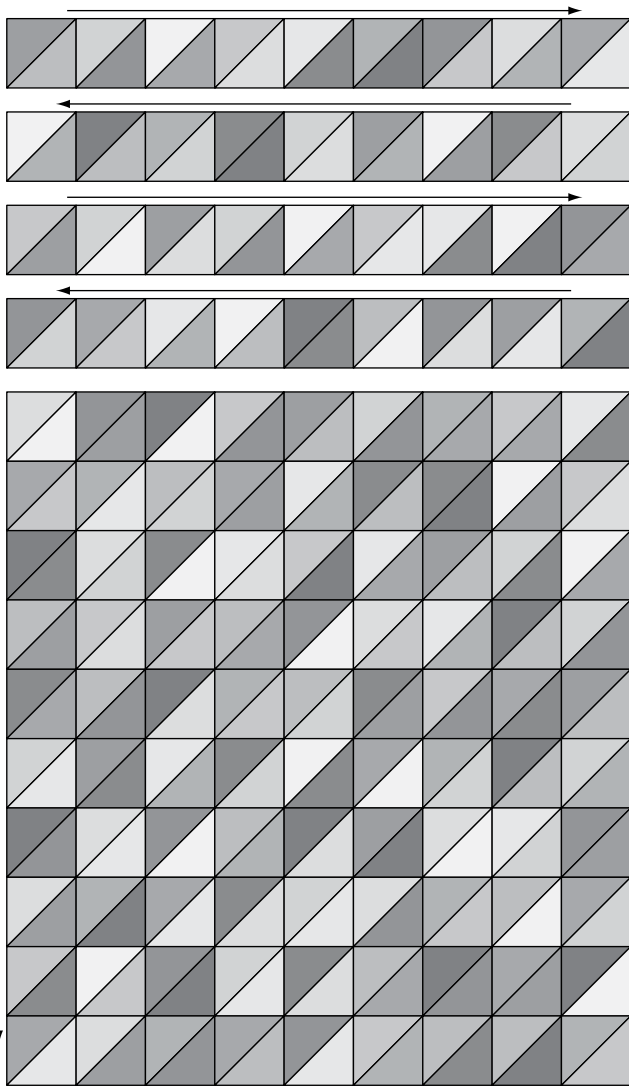
Make 126.

2. Sew 9 blocks together in a row. Repeat to make a total of 14 rows. Press seams in opposite directions from row to row, as shown on next page.



Make 14.

3. Sew rows together to make quilt top.

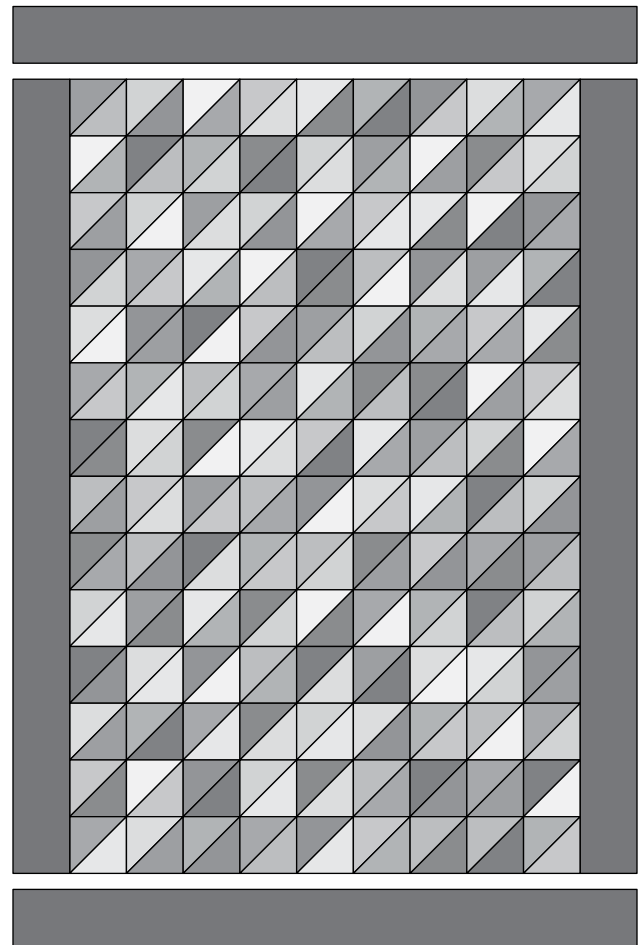


## Borders

1. Measure length of quilt top through center. Cut 2 Blue/Yellow Sun Flowers strips to this measurement, and sew to sides of quilt as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press seams toward borders.
2. Measure width of quilt top, including borders just added, through center. Trim 2 remaining Blue/Yellow Sun Flowers strips to this measurement, and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward borders.

## Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
