

# Dazzling Diamonds

**FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 73½" x 82½"**

## **Materials**

*Yardage requirements are based on 40" fabric width.*

⅝ yd. each of Turquoise Peacock Collage (1PC2), Blue Large Floral (2PC1), Orange Eyes (4PC2), Blue Floral Arcs (5PC1), Orange/Green Floral Arcs (5PC2), Blue Small Floral (6PC1), Orange Linear Bubbles (7PC2), Turquoise Tonal Circles (8PC2), Orange Tonal Circles (8PC5), Green Tonal Circles (8PC6) for diamonds

3½ yds. White Tonal Circles (8PC4) for diamonds and inner border

2⅓ yds. Blue Peacock Collage (1PC1) for diamonds and outer border

1¼ yds. Blue Tonal Circles (8PC1) for diamonds and binding

4⅞ yds. for backing (widthwise seam)

## **Cutting**

*Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed. IMPORTANT NOTE: Cut outer border and binding strips first, as listed below. Leftovers from those prints can then be used for cutting diamonds.*

### **Cutting Outer Border and Binding Strips**

*From Blue Peacock Collage, cut:*

- 4 strips, 4½" x length of fabric, for outer border (Strips are cut long, and will be trimmed to size later.)

*From Blue Tonal Circles, cut:*

- 9 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding

### **Cutting Inner Border and White Diamonds**

*From White Tonal Circles, cut in order given:*

- 7 strips, 1½" x 40", for inner border
- 82 diamonds, using Diamond Template (on back page)

### **Cutting Multi-Color Diamonds**

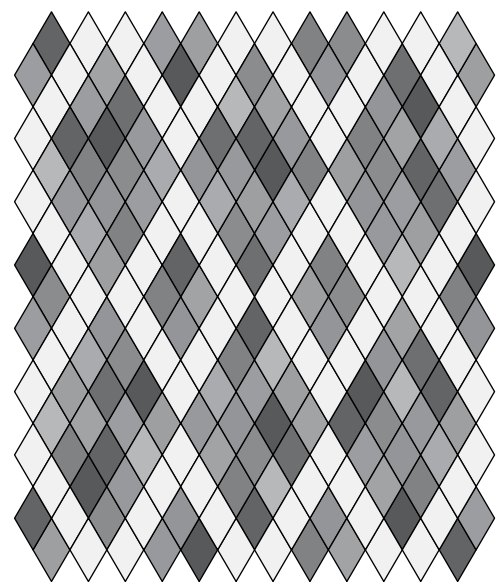
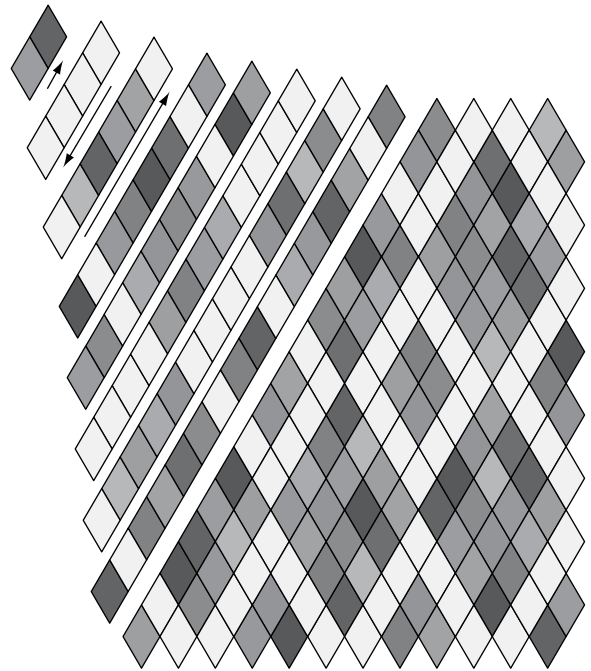
*From Turquoise Peacock Collage, Blue Large Floral, Orange Eyes, Blue Floral Arcs, Orange/Green Floral Arcs, Blue Small Floral, Orange Linear Bubbles, Turquoise Tonal Circles, Orange Tonal Circles, Green Tonal Circles – and leftovers of Blue Peacock Collage and Blue Tonal Circles, cut a total of:*

- 130 diamonds, using Diamond Template (on back page)

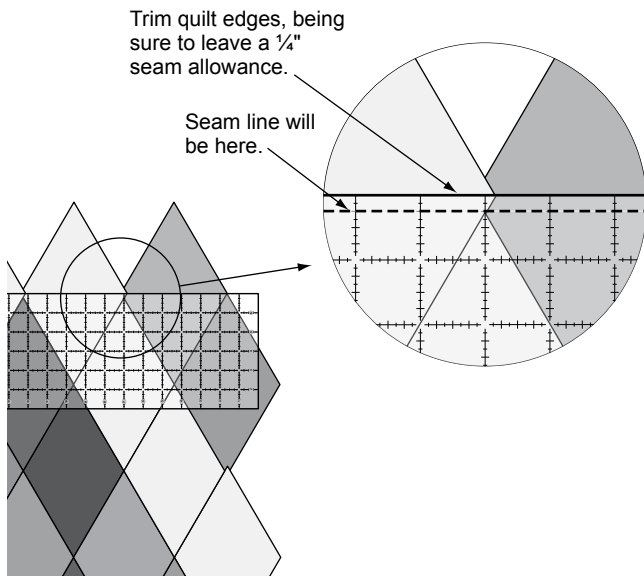
## **Quilt Top Assembly**

*All seams ¼". Press seams in direction of arrows unless otherwise instructed.*

1. Referring to photograph for fabric placement, sew diamonds together in diagonal rows as shown below. Press seams in opposite directions from row to row. Then sew diagonal rows together; press seams in one direction.

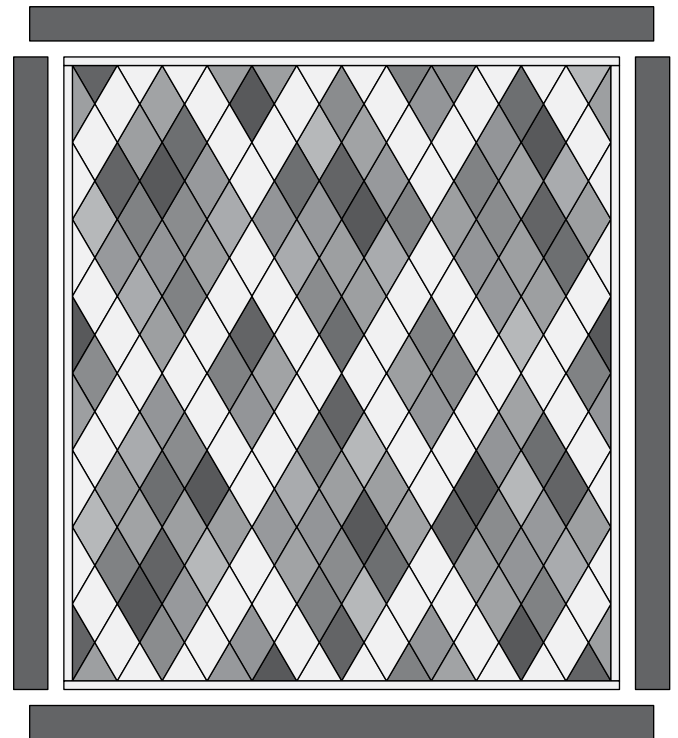


- Using a long acrylic ruler and a rotary cutter, trim all sides of your quilt top, *being sure to leave a ¼" seam allowance.*



### Borders

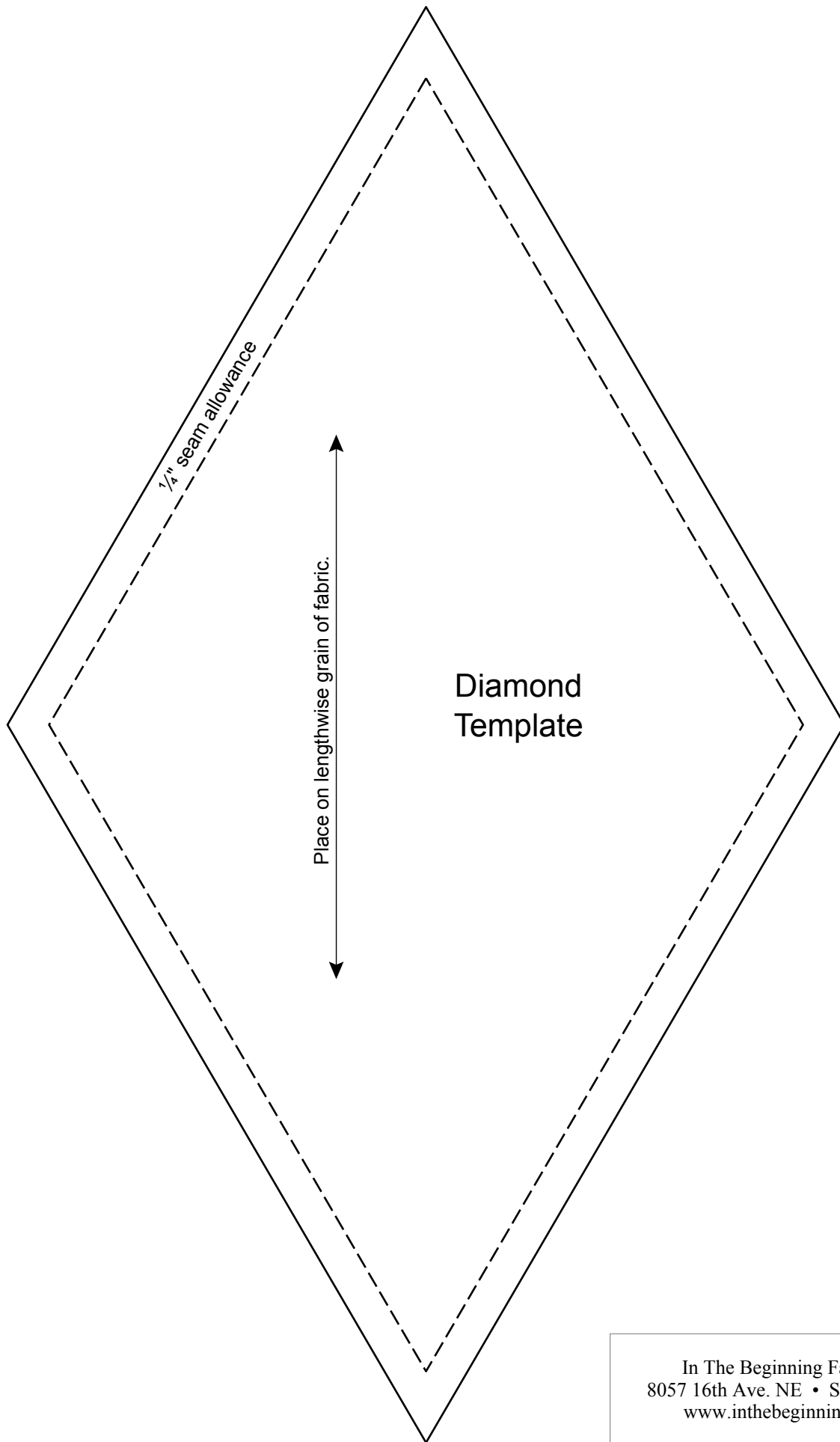
- Sew White Tonal Circles inner border strips together, end-to-end, to make one long strip.
- Measure length of quilt top through center. From the long strip, cut 2 inner border strips to this measurement, and sew to sides of quilt as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press seams toward inner borders.
- Measure width of quilt top, including borders just added, through center. From the long strip, cut 2 inner border strips to this measurement, and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward inner borders.
- Measure length of quilt top through center. Trim 2 Blue Peacock Collage outer border strips to this measurement, and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward outer borders.
- Measure width of quilt top, including borders just added, through center. Trim remaining 2 Blue Peacock Collage outer border strips to this measurement, and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward outer borders.

### Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
